Web Development

I am currently building sites in Typescript NextJS with either a MongoDb or PostgresSql backend. I finally decided to take the plunge and dive into vanilla javascript and modern frameworks in Nov 2023. Before that I had been building vanilla html and CSS sites since 2008 and worked with PHP and Perl extensively as a network engineer.

Data analytics

In the last year I do 90% of my work in Microsoft SQL Management Studio, Excel and Powerpoint. I have previously worked extensively with Python as a scripting language to manipulate data — never really done anything meaningful from a modelling point of view because I was more interested in using the outputs of the models to make interesting digital decisions that lead to value creation for the business and our customers. I have also used PowerBI extensively over the last 7 years but the preference of my recent line management has been more manual reporting.

I managed a team of 9 people for 18 months but prefer to manage smaller teams of technical people. I like to be involved in the details of what my team is working on and enjoy collaborating with people I respect to solve problems. I am a competent presenter and can effectively communicate with junior staff and senior executives.

I have also found that I tend to enjoy a single meaty problem to focus on rather than attending many meetings and keeping plates spinning.

I am very happy with the decision to focus on a specialist technical career and now spend my days deeply analysing campaign performance and building algorithms and processes to drive value for our customers and the bank.
